Gary Yong Gee

'Trekking in Yunnan'.

Yunnan is a province of South China that borders Vietnam, Laos and Myanmar. The climate varies from hot lowland to high mountainous areas. As well as showing the indigenous species, Gary showed rural scenes, the people and tourist attractions including local markets and a water splashing festival.

Some of the species that Gary showed were;

Lowlands *Den. cariniferum* *Den. devonianum*

Highlands *Cym. hookerianum* *Cym. lowianum* *Pleione albiflora* *Coelogyne*
corymbosa *Pleione forrestii* *Vandopsis undulata*

Gary also highlighted the issue of species collection from their natural setting; showing large numbers for sale at markets although some are propagated in nurseries. Wild collection meant that some species were difficult to find and get close enough to photograph. He drew attention to the Orchid Conservation Alliance which raises funds to purchase land and save habitat. They run tours with some profits going towards their funding
